

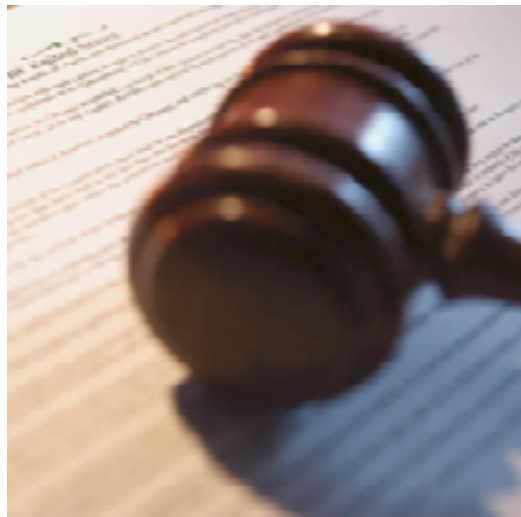


Principles of Public Service

Summary

Principles of Public Service instructs participants in the importance of municipal-context employees being above reproach in following ethical standards and codes. Ethical behavior and legal behavior are not the same. Legal actions are not always ethical ones; you can step over the boundary of ethical behavior and still be inside the law.

This course includes group discussion over ethical dilemmas, guidelines for deciding what is ethical and what is not ethical, and discussion and application of the six pillars of character.
