**ABOUT THE POSITION**

The Assistant Utilities Director is an advanced professional position that directs, oversees, supervises, and coordinates the activities of employees of the Infrastructure Department Utilities Division, including utilities engineering, water and wastewater infrastructure maintenance, water and wastewater treatment operations, storm water engineering and infrastructure maintenance, and water resource operations. The Assistant Director is also responsible for technical work planning, prioritizing, and implementing the Utilities Capital Improvement program in the Infrastructure Department. This position reviews project plans related to development proposals, water, wastewater, storm water utility improvements, and water resource development and acquisition; conducts long-term planning activities; oversees contract projects to ensure adherence with standards and specifications; and coordinates with other City departments and represents the City in various public venues, local and regional professional work groups, including local and regional governmental planning organizations. Work is performed with appreciable latitude for independent judgment and action that is reviewed by the Director of Infrastructure through observation, conferences, reports, and achievement of desired objectives.

This position supports the goals of the Infrastructure Department, which maintains and enhances the safety and well-being of the community by providing exceptional water, wastewater, and storm water service and maintaining the City's extensive network of utility infrastructure. The department continuously strives to meet the needs of the community by constantly focusing on customer service, efficient and effective utilization of resources, safety, innovation, and teamwork.

This position must work well independently and in group settings, with peers and with the public, while providing excellent, respectful customer service and human relations skills, which support the City of Brighton's mission and values.

The City offers a competitive salary with negotiable relocation assistance.

## EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

The selected candidate should hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major coursework in civil engineering or a related field. Seven to ten years of progressively responsible experience in the management of utilities infrastructure including but not limited to design, construction, and maintenance of water/wastewater systems and facilities, storm water systems, and related utilities system functions and operations is required. The chosen candidate must be registered with the Colorado State Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors as a professional engineer (P.E.), or have the ability to become registered within 6 months of hire. The candidate must have a valid driver's license with a safe driving record and must have the ability to complete FEMA ICS 100 and IS 700 training within six months of hire.

A master's degree in civil or environmental engineering or a related field; three to five years of supervision of professional level engineers, technical, and maintenance staff; and three to five years of municipal utility infrastructure capital improvement project experience are preferred qualifications. Bilingual Spanish/English preferred.
