Abilene is a culturally rich, fast-growing city in West Texas known for its western heritage, regional economic leadership, and welcoming community spirit. It serves as a hub for healthcare, education, and commerce for a 22-county area. With strong ties to Dyess Air Force Base, Abilene benefits from a patriotic, service-oriented community and a diversified economy supported by public and private investments. Abilene is the new frontier for emerging technology, with the largest Al infrastructure project in the United States underway.

The city is home to three universities (Abilene Christian University, Hardin-Simmons University, and McMurry University), multiple medical centers, and a vibrant downtown undergoing major revitalization. Residents enjoy a high quality of life with family-friendly attractions like the Abilene Zoo, Storybook Capital of America public art, outdoor recreation, and numerous festivals and cultural events.

Abilene is well-positioned along I-20, approximately 180 miles west of Dallas-Fort Worth, offering a relaxed lifestyle with easy access to metropolitan amenities.

GOVERNANCE & ORGANIZATION

The City of Abilene operates under a Council-Manager form of government. The City Council includes a Mayor and six Council Members elected by single-member districts and at-large positions to serve three-year terms. No term limits apply.

- Public Works & Utilities
- Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Affairs
- Airport

The Deputy City Manager is appointed by and reports directly to the City Manager.

- 5+ years as Assistant/Deputy City Manager or equivalent
- Familiarity with Texas municipal operations and TMRS
- Active membership in the Texas City Management Association (TCMA) and/or International City/ County Management Association (ICMA) preferred
- Must possess a valid Texas driver's license or be able to obtain one within 90 days of hire

COMPENSATION & BENEFITS

Health Insurance: Medical, dental, and vision insurance available to all full-time employees and their dependents. Premiums for employee coverage are paid by the City. HDHP and EPO options available through BCBS of Texas.

Paid Leave: 12 paid holidays annually, vacation accrual per pay period, and 10 hours/month of sick leave. Additional leave includes bereavement, military, and jury duty.

Retirement: Membership in the Texas Municipal Retirement System (TMRS) with a 7% employee contribution and 2:1 employer match. Optional 457 plan with Roth option available.

- Stability pay for non-civil service employees
- Direct deposit to multiple accounts
- Free access to the City's COACH health clinic
- Employee discounts with local attractions, universities, and wireless carriers
