

BACKGROUND & GOVERNANCE

ATP is the local government corporation leading the planning, design, construction and implementation of Austin Light Rail. The new light rail system will be an infrastructure improvement unlike any other in Austin's history and transform how people move around our city. Our team of experts includes a diverse mix of Austin locals and professionals from across the country.

ATP is currently in the planning, design, and development phase and expects Austin's light rail to officially open with 9.8 miles of track in 2033.

Key facts:

- Light rail is an electric-powered train system that runs on its own dedicated railway and offers riders direct street-level access.
- Austin Light Rail Phase 1 will provide access to some of the city's most-visited destinations—connecting locals and visitors to where they need and want to go.
- ATP's Board of Directors provides strategic oversight of implementation and delivery of Austin Light Rail.



THE JOB

The Senior Vice President of Financial Services is responsible for leading ATP's financial planning, budgeting, and government treasury functions in alignment with strategic capital and operational priorities. ATP has been recognized with a GFOA Budget Award and values continued excellence in government sector financial reporting. This executive leadership position reports to the Chief Financial Officer and plays a vital role in guiding the financial strategy across the entire project lifecycle—from pre-construction to long-term operations and maintenance.

Reporting to the CFO, the Senior VP of Financial Services will:

- Develop ATP's annual budget and long-term financial forecasts
- Ensure the financial model assumptions align with the agency's capital (infrastructure) improvement plan
- Prepare and present financial plans and quarterly reports to ATP's Board of Directors and Advisory Committees
- Support and advise on budgetary control functions within the ERP platform (Oracle Fusion)
- Direct and supervise the various aspects of the Treasury function which includes cash management, investment management and debt management
- Develop standard internal budgetary reporting framework for executive management
